

Master's and Doctoral Thesis Description

The master's/doctoral thesis is a carefully argued intellectual paper of approximately 5,000 words (roughly 15-20 pages) for master's and 8,500 words (roughly 20-25 pages) for doctoral. It should present an original argument that is carefully documented from primary and/or secondary sources.

The thesis must have a substantial research component and a focus that falls within Religion and Christian Education, and it must be written under the guidance of an advisor.

As the final element in the master's and doctoral degree, the thesis gives the student an opportunity to demonstrate expertise in the chosen research area. You may select your own topic.

Thesis Formatting Requirement

- Yes, your thesis must conform to the following guidelines:
- The cover page must include the thesis title, your name, and your student ID number; your advisor's name and a space for her or his approval signature; the month and year the degree will be conferred (not the month in which the thesis is submitted)
- The thesis should be Computerize and sent to email

- We prefer an unbound thesis. A simple folder clip is sufficient. If you decide to bind your thesis, please make sure that your original, signed cover page is unbound.
